FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Complainant, the North Carolina Department of Labor, by and through its Commissioner, is an agency of the State of North Carolina charged with inspection for, compliance with, and enforcement of the provisions of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 95-126 et. seq., the Occupational Safety and Health Act of North Carolina (the "Act").
- 2. Complainant issued to Respondent 1 citation with 5 items (Items 1,2, 3a, 3b and 4), with associated penalties in the total amount of \$2,800.00 (collectively referred to as "Citation 1"). Respondent filed a Notice of Contest contesting Citation 1.
- 3. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this Hearing.

4. Neither party presented any procedural objection to this Hearing.

A conference between the parties and the undersigned was held prior to the scheduled Hearing. As a result of the conference, at the Hearing Complainant made the following Motion:

Complainant moved to delete Citation 1 and corresponding penalties in its entirety, with Respondent agreeing to the following conditions: upon hiring an employee Respondent will, as applicable, perform fall protection training and document that training; insure that employees are provided and use fall protection equipment; perform ladder training and conduct frequent and regular inspections of its worksite, all in accordance with OSHA regulations; all training to be conducted within 1 week of hire, to the extent applicable.

Respondent did not object to Complainant's Motion and Complainant's Motion is hereby GRANTED.
