THIS CAUSE coming on pursuant to the Order of Pre-Hearing Conference ("Hearing Order") on September 21, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. via the Lifesize teleconferencing platform. Jonathan D. Jones, Assistant Attorney General, and Rory Agan, Special Deputy Attorney General, North Carolina Department of Justice, Raleigh, North Carolina, appeared as counsel for the Complainant. Thomas L. Pursuant to the Hearing Order a pre-hearing conference (the "Hearing") was held for the purpose of considering matters which would simplify the issues and expedite the proceedings in the above referenced case. At the Hearing Complainant gave notice that it is withdrawing the Original Citation ("Withdrawal"). NC Commission Rule .0401 provides that Complainant may withdraw a citation "[a]t any stage of a proceeding". The Supreme Court in Cuyahoga Valley Railway Co. v United Transportation Union, 474 U.S. 3, 7 (1985), held "the Secretary's decision to withdraw a citation against an employer under the Act is not reviewable by the Commission." Under Cuyahoga, the Undersigned does not have the authority to grant or deny Complainant's withdrawal of the Original Citation. The Withdrawal by Complainant is self-effectuating and terminates the case in and of itself; no order of the Undersigned is needed or required.

Therefore, the Undersigned issues this Order acknowledging Complainant's Withdrawal and the closing of this case; this action is a ministerial function only – not a substantive one. Immediate effect is given to Complainant's Withdrawal of the Original Citation.
