NOW COME the parties in the above-captioned action, pursuant to Rule .0701 of the Rules of Procedure adopted by the North Carolina Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission, and respectfully show unto the Hearing Examiner as follows:

FACTS

- Respondent is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of North Carolina and maintains a place of business in Mocksville, North Carolina.
- Complainant is an agency of the State of North Carolina charged by law with the administration and enforcement of the provisions of the North Carolina Occupational Safety and Health Act.
- 3. On July 29, 2021, Jennifer Boone (formerly Busick) and Warren Lutz, Occupational Safety and Health Officers with the North Carolina Department of Labor, conducted an inspection of the worksite located at 5665 Cedarmere Drive, Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

4. As a result of the inspection, on August 25, 2021, Complainant issued two citations, carrying the following abatement dates and penalties:

- 5. The Respondent submitted a timely Notice of Contest, dated October 5, 2021.
- 6. The parties having reached a Settlement Agreement now seek approval of said Agreement by the Hearing Examiner.

STIPULATIONS

Effective upon approval of this Stipulation and Notice of Settlement, the parties to this action hereby agree and stipulate to the following settlement of the matters at issue herein:

- Respondent agrees that the violations alleged in the Citation and Notification of Penalty,
 as amended, have been abated, and agrees to continue to use its best efforts to comply with
 the requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of North Carolina (hereinafter
 referred to as the "Act").
- 2. Complainant agrees to make the following amendments to the Citations:
 - a. Delete Citation 1, Item 1, and the penalty associated therewith; and
 - b. Keep Citation 2, Item 1, as issued.
- 3. Respondent agrees to the following:

- a. The Respondent will conduct frequent and regular safety and health inspections for the identification of worksite hazards. Hazards observed shall be immediately corrected and employees provided with training and information on those hazards observed within their work areas.
- b. The Respondent agrees to conduct retraining within six months for all of Respondent's crane operators related to pre-planning routes for the loads to ensure employees and other individuals are kept outside of the fall zone when flying a load except the employees necessary for the hooking or unhooking of the load. Respondent will make documentation of that retraining available to North Carolina Department of Labor personnel upon request.
- 4. The parties agree to bear their own attorney's fees, costs and other expenses that have been incurred in connection with any stage of these proceedings up to and including the filing of this Stipulation and Notice of Settlement.
- 5. Respondent agrees that by signing this Stipulation and Notice of Settlement and upon approval of said Stipulation and Notice of Settlement by the Hearing Examiner, its Notice of Contest is withdrawn as a matter of law. In any subsequent proceeding with respect to matters covered by this Stipulation and Notice of Settlement brought directly under the Act by Complainant, this Agreement shall have the full force and effect of a final order.
- 6. The parties agree that there are no other matters that remain to be decided, and there has been no employee objection to the reasonableness of any abatement period.
- 7. The posting requirements of Notice of Settlement are waived as the matter came on for hearing during a properly noticed hearing, no affected employees were present and the agreement was reached during the hearing.

WHEREFORE, the parties to this action hereby respectfully request approval of this

Stipulation and Notice of Settlement.

NOTICE OF FILING BY WAY OF ELECTRONIC MEANS
